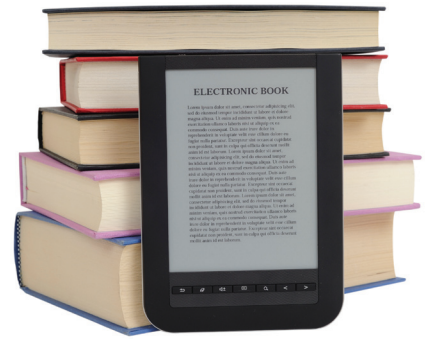


# eBooks @ Your Library

## How do I find a Kindle book?

- Go to [library.carr.org](http://library.carr.org)
- Click the **Find Books and More** tab
- Go to **Digital Titles** at left
- Click the **Login** tab
- Find **Carroll County** in the drop down
- Enter your library card number and PIN
- Search for and checkout a Kindle book title
- Click the **Get for Kindle** button after checkout and the Amazon.com website will open for book download (sign in may be required)
- Select a Kindle device or Kindle reading app, then click the **Get library book** button to sync the book to your device or app\*
- Read and enjoy!

\* An active Wi-Fi connection is required for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you may transfer the files via a USB connection.

## How do I find an eBook?

- Go to [library.carr.org](http://library.carr.org)
- Click the **Find Books and More** tab
- Go to **Digital Titles** at left
- Click the **Login** tab
- Find **Carroll County** in the drop down
- Enter your library card number and PIN
- Search for and download a title
- Download **Adobe Digital Editions**
- Connect your eReader to your computer (the device name appears in Adobe Digital Editions)
- Drag and drop the book to the device icon at left
- Read and enjoy!
