CCPL Closed in Coordination with Statewide COVID-19 Response

Carroll County, MD – Carroll County Public Library is expected to remain closed through April 12. This closure is out of an abundance of caution and aligned with the Governor's response plan for social distancing during the COVID-19 health crisis.

All branches will continue to be closed. All private meeting room bookings, library programs, and library events are cancelled during this time. Additionally, all CCPL programs will be canceled through May 3.

Customers are encouraged to keep any materials currently checked out and then return them when the library reopens. No fines will be accrued on overdue materials during this closure and through May 3. Customer holds will also be held for an additional week once the libraries reopen.
