CCPL Closes in Coordination with Statewide COVID-19 Response

Carroll County, MD – Carroll County Public Library will be closed from March 14 through March 29. This closure is out of an abundance of caution and aligned with the Governor's response plan for social distancing during the COVID-19 health crisis.

All branches will be closed during this two-week period, which matches the closure period of other services, including Carroll County Public Schools. All private meeting room bookings, library programs, and library events are cancelled.

Customers are encouraged to keep any materials currently checked out and then return them when the library reopens. No fines will be accrued on overdue materials during this closure. Customer holds will also be held for an additional week once the libraries reopen.
