CCPL Invites Artists of All Ages to Create Artwork for Future Library Cards

Carroll County, MD – Carroll County Public Library (CCPL) invites the community to participate in designing limited edition library cards. CCPL is entering a new phase of library service with the construction of Exploration Commons at 50 East. Exploration Commons at 50 East is an interactive space coming to the Westminster Branch in 2021, where the community can explore and create using the unique equipment and resources in the Makerspace, Teaching Kitchen, and Meeting Spaces. In celebration of all things that a library can be, CCPL asks the community to design limited edition library cards based on the theme of Infinite Possibilities. There are two age categories: one for kids and teens, and another category for adults with first, second, and third prizes for each category. Prize awards are made possible by The Friends of Carroll County Public Library.
