Carroll County Public Library Provides Free Access to *The Baltimore Sun* and *Carroll County Times*

Carroll County, MD – Carroll County Public Library's collection of digital materials now includes free access to current issues of both *The Baltimore Sun* and *Carroll County Times* with your library card. In addition, you can view digital archived issues of the Carroll County Times, which are available online at https://cctimes.carr.org/. These archives connect our community with local news and historic content spanning as far back as the early 1900s, along with the latest articles on current developments from across the county, the state, the country, and the globe.

Library cardholders who are interested in accessing new issues of *The Baltimore Sun* and *Carroll County Times* can do so by logging in at <u>https://access.medianewsgroup.com/d/ccpl</u> with the barcode on their library card and their Carroll County Public Library account password. Maryland residents interested in getting their own free library card can register for a free Carroll County Public Library card in person or online. To register in person, simply visit the customer service desk at any of our branch locations with an acceptable ID, such as a driver's license, to register for a card. You may register online for a temporary library card before visiting a branch with an acceptable ID to pick up your official library card. You will be allowed to place requests and check out up to 2 items before your 30-day temporary card expires.
